Reservation and Eligibility Criteria for the Students

The admission procedure at S. S. Jain Subodh P.G. College, Jaipur follows the guidelines set by the Commissionerate of College Education, Rajasthan, including its own reservation policy due to the status of Minority Institution by the Ministry of Minority Affairs, Govt. of Rajasthan. The college believes in providing education opportunity equally to all aspirants apart of their caste, creed, gender, status etc. As per the state government's directives for non-minority institutions, certain percentage of seats are reserved for students belonging to different categories such as Scheduled Castes (SC 16%), Scheduled Tribes (ST- 12%), Other Backward Classes (OBC-21%), and Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) and Others. If the OBC applicants are more than the reservation criteria percentage and SC/ST are less, the institution absorbs all the OBC applicants to comply with the government's intention of equitable education opportunities for all. The Government also clarifies this for shifting to SC/ST and OBC Category among itself. The reservation criteria always aim to ensure equitable access to education and promote diversity within the student admissions. In case of vacant seats availability during the admissions for reserved categories, the seats are filled with the general category students on merit basis. It is also in Govt. Policy. It also increases the

Gross Enrollment Ratio (GER). In spite of minority status of the college, college formulated modified reservation policy in which SC/ST/OBC candidates are also given the chance and we have almost have the requisite number of reserved category students.
