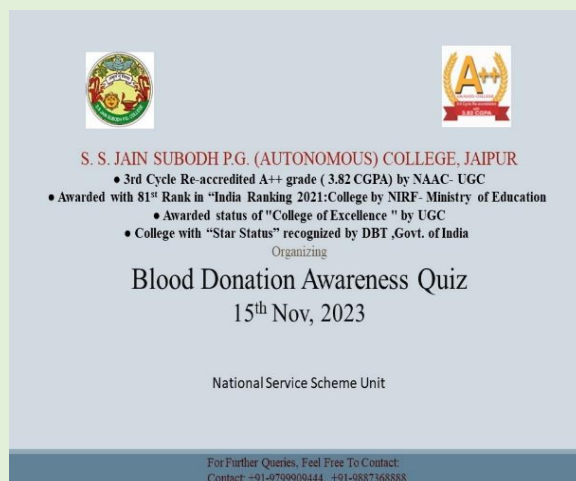

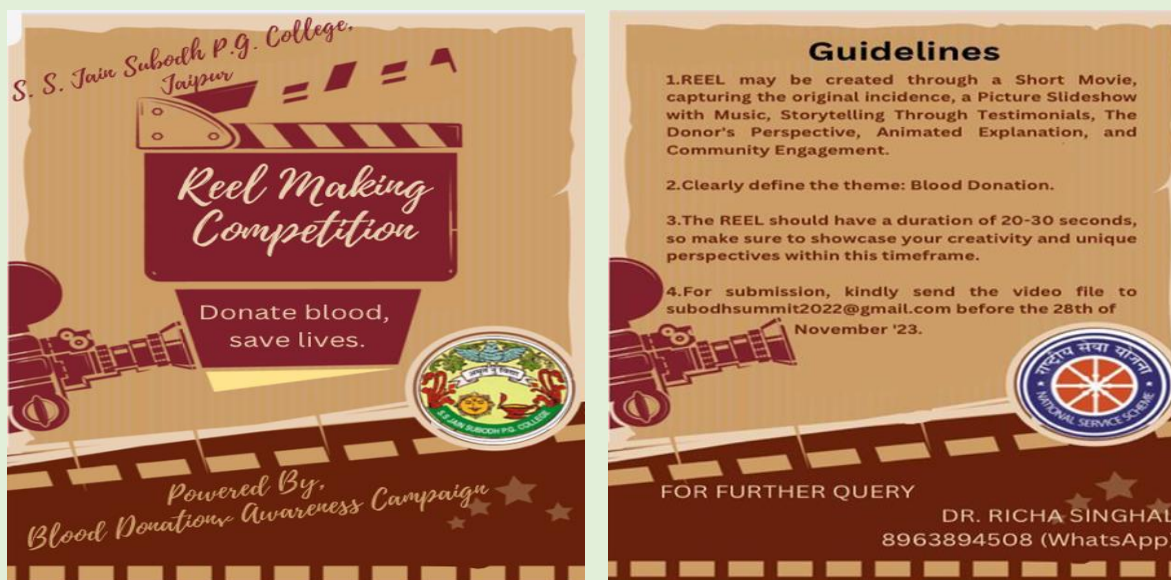
5 . Blood Donation Awareness programmes-
