



Human Trafficking in India

What is human trafficking?

Human trafficking is the trade of humans most commonly for the purpose of sexual slavery, forced labour or commercial sexual exploitation for the traffickers or others. This is the acquisition of people by the improper means such as force, fraud or deception with the aim of exploiting them.

People included in such racket digs money about \$150bn every year. Now we can split the victims of HUMAN TRAFFICKING into the following. Out of 100%, 71% of women & girls and men & boys together makes to the rest 29%. There are 21 million victims worldwide. Out of which 54% are of sexual exploitation, 38% forced labour and 8% other purposes, including organ trafficking. As per the officials estimates 15 children go missing every hour in India and 8 are never found. That is nearly 50% of it. We all are very acquainted with the term human trafficking or it is sometime referred as modern-day slavery which has become a large exercise in contemporary times from beyond few years. After drug and arms, human trafficking is the third most heinous global crimes.

We only wakeup when there is a horrifying blood curdling incidents, we rush to the streets to express our concern, seek stringent laws, and call for death for every criminal in the world in these dastardly acts, but soon enough these incidents are blotted out from public memory until the next horror incident takes over. Despite reports almost every day with time we have become immune to the stories of exploitation of persons in several ways

Various laws are made for such offence. These laws are in Article 21(1), Article 24, the immoral traffic (prevention) Act 1956, Criminal law amendment act 2013 and others.

Various schemes are also made for the rehabilitation for women. These schemes can be classified as

- 1. Ujjawala and Sudhar Grah
- 2. Anti Human Trafficking Units.

Human trafficking is done not only for sex work but for labour work which is forced. Forced labour takes on many forms. It happens throughout oversees through force, fraud or coercion. Victims are made to work for little or no pay, very often these victims are forced to manufacture or grow the products we use and consume every day. Victims of forced labour can be found in factories and farms, doing construction work and more. Victims of domestic servitude are hidden in plain sight where they are forced to work in homes across the country. Their traffickers sometimes take their identification paper and travel documents in order to limit their freedom and to keep them anonymous. They are prisoners working as maids or domestic help. Every year in India thousands of human trafficking cases are reported but many more go unnoticed. That is because human trafficking is a hidden crime. Victims of human trafficking might be afraid to come forward or we may not recognize them, even it is happening right in front of us. We need to bring this crime out of the shadows and to take a stand against modern-day slavery and help combat this heinous crime by raising awareness of human trafficking around the country.

But we can't do it alone we need your help so what you can do to stop human trafficking? Be an informed consumer, know who makes the products you buy and food you eat to help keep slavery tainted items out of your home. And finally recognize and report suspected human trafficking.
