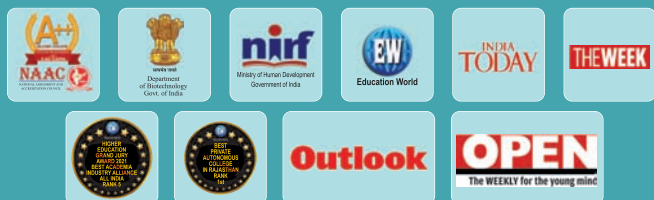

- On February 8, 2023 a MoU has been signed with Azim Premji University, Bengaluru to generate resources in social sciences, sciences, humanities, public health and other subjects in Indian languages. It will provide the required resources to facilitate the collaborative projects from time to time. It is collaboration for the seminars, workshop, debates, discussion, translation work and any other academic activities for academic enrichment of both institutions.

- The college has signed a MoU with Nirjeet Entertainments on December 10, 2022 under which Nirjeet Entertainments will organize film-making and acting workshops for our students and exhibit the films made by the students in Khamma -Ghani Film-Festival Jaipur -2024.

- A MoU was signed with Icon Seeds (P) Ltd., Jaipur on December 7, 2022 to work together to enhance business skills and provide opportunities of practical exposure for the betterment of the students.

- The college has signed a MoU with the ICT Academy. The ICT Academy is an initiative of the Government of India in collaboration with the state Governments and Industries. ICT Academy was started in the year 2009 and is a not-for-profit society, the first of its kind pioneer venture under the Public-Private-Partnership (PPP) model that endeavours to train the higher education teachers and students thereby exercises on developing the next generation teachers and industry read students.

- In 2022, college had signed a MoU with Dileep Industries, one of the largest exporters of handicraft products in India. - MoU had been signed with NGO's Upvan Seva Sansthan, Samrish Society and Samajik Anveshan Avam Shodh Sansthan, to work for the betterment of underprivileged sections of the society. It is a constructive step to carry out beneficial activities like health and hygiene camps, awareness rally, motivational and fun activities etc. for the deprived, needy and less fortunate children living in the orphanages, slums and rehabilitation centers.

- Praveen Lata Sansthan and Satya, All India Welfare Society Girl Child Protection & Promotion are other non-government organizations with whom institution is allied for various activities for deprived and needy children of the society.

- Institution also has the linkage with Bhandari Hospital and Research Centre, Jaipur for providing prompt services, ambulance and other facilities to college staff and their family members. College has an authorized centre of RKCL (Rajasthan Knowledge Corporation Limited) to develop a new educational framework which can plan, implement, supervise and regulate the developing needs for IT skills.

It marks first impression on students' minds as it is their second home, a place where they can identify themselves, shape their career and have the expert guidance to walk on the right path. Subodh campus is vast spread over an area of ten acres and is situated in the heart of the city. An awe-inspiring Wi-Fi enabled infrastructure comprises of well-ventilated classrooms, labs, library, canteen, seminar halls and many more. The multistorey college premises is enriched with state-of-the-art facilities such as computer labs, science labs, smart rooms, etc. to cater to the need of imparting conceptual and practical knowledge among the students. The infrastructural design enriches activities as per the global needs. Safety is ensured through manpower security, proper camera surveillance and firefighting panels throughout the corridors. The college campus proudly hosts green initiatives such as solar panels, rainwater harvesting system, compost plant, segregated bins for wet and dry garbage and sincerely ensures a "no plastic" and "no tobacco" zone.

RECEPTION

As per the traditional slogan of Rajasthan "*Padhaaro Mahre Desh*", each visitor is welcomed with warmth and tenderness. Receptionist is usually the very first point of communication where the students and visitors get to interact with the college administration. Various queries regarding admission and day-to-day activities are handled effectively. It is an active counseling zone. During the admission time the representatives of all the Departments are available to provide career and admission guidance to the aspirants.

OPEN AIR STAGE

Open air stage is situated in the center of the college amidst a lush green garden. It is used to conduct various intra and intercollegiate academic and cultural activities viz. debate competition, quiz competition, national science exhibition, techno fair, job fair etc. in the college. It is an open stage having the capacity to accommodate more than 2500 spectators.

AUDITORIUMS

Currently, the college has two auditoriums. Both the auditoriums are a visual delight with a seating capacity of 350 persons each. Each auditorium is centrally air conditioned and exhibits architectural brilliance through its infrastructure which symbolizes an amalgamation of the culture with modern technology. The cultural events and academic presentations come alive in these auditoriums which are beautifully designed and equipped with all

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updated facilities in such a way that several national and international events can be effortlessly hosted here.

CONFERENCE HALL

Deliberation is a great way to communicate and vital for the development and enhancement of an individual and educational system as a whole. For this, the college has air conditioned conference hall with a seating arrangement for 60 members. The conference hall provides facilities and services for academic meetings, seminars, workshops and conferences. It is equipped with the latest technical gadgets like projection system, Wi-Fi connectivity, electrical and LAN connection for laptops etc.

SEMINAR HALLS

The college has two seminar halls to conduct academic / non-academic activities for the all-round development of students. Both the seminar halls have advanced audio-visual facilities & LCD projectors with a seating capacity of 400 people taken together. Guest lectures, presentations, workshops, cultural events or any extracurricular / co-curricular activities of the various departments or college are organized in these seminar halls.

LECTURE THEATRE

The college has lecture theatre equipped with modern ICT teaching aids and has a seating capacity of 175 students to aid the process of learning. In lecture theatre, various activities like workshops, presentations, guest lectures and seminars are conducted effectively. Apart from this, it is also used for conduction of industry interaction programs.

SMART CLASS ROOMS

To keep pace with the technological advancement in pedagogy of teaching and making learning an exhilarating experience, the college has smart class rooms to cater to the smart generation of new India. The college has five smart class rooms which facilitates ICT based learning. They ensure encouragement to smart studies through exploration of web resources and an effective knowledge transfer. The smart classroom enables utilization of the computer, projector, internet and multimedia devices to maintain pace with the modern education scenario.



ITIES

OFFICE BLOCK

To streamline and systemize the functioning of the college, the Office-Block comprises of cubicles for office staff along with computers and Wi-Fi connectivity. This block provides information regarding scholarships, fee submission, identity cards, mark sheets etc.

AUTONOMOUS FRONT OFFICE

To keep pace with the growing requirements of the autonomous activities of the college, a well-furnished Autonomous Front office has been set up in the campus, comprising of highly efficient administrative staff members. Queries related to Autonomous Status and its functioning, examinations, results or query related to any discipline can be sorted out in this office.

FACULTY ROOMS

Institution has well-ventilated air-cooled faculty rooms with ICT facilities along with pantry and washroom. These serve as a place where staff can relax before or after class, live discussion with colleagues, plan lessons, eat lunch, discuss educational issues and socialize. There is access to the high-speed internet facilities through Wi-Fi. Major departments have their individual faculty rooms.

RESEARCH CENTRES

The college promotes research-oriented approach to enrich the Teaching-Learning environment in the college. At present the college has four separate educational Research centres for the departments of Physics, Computer Science, Mathematics and Commerce.

Department of Physics is involved in following three core areas of research:

1. Microwave Electronics group : (Research led by Prof. K.B. Sharma) The centre has high-end facilities like Generators, Wave Guides, Measuring Instruments, Radiating and receiving antennas, Vector Network Analyzer (VNA) and Anechoic Chamber.
2. Energy Storage group: (Research led by Dr. Balram Tripathi) This centre is equipped with Composite fabrication setup, Hydrogen storage setup, Impedance analyzer, Charging-discharging setup.
3. Condensed Matter Physics group: (Researchers: Dr. S.C. Agarwal

and Dr. S.P. Pareek) The centre has the facilities like Thin Film Coating Unit, Hydraulic Press Unit (20 ton), Nano-materials Synthesis Unit, Muffle Furnace (1000°C), XRD, FT-IR spectrophotometer, Atomic Absorption Spectrometer, uv-visible spectrophotometer, Magnetic Stirrers, Pelletizer, Digital Microbalance and Battery tester.

Dr. S.C. Agarwal, Dr. Balram Tripathi and Dr. S.P. Pareek of Department of Physics are the research supervisors approved by University of Rajasthan, Jaipur.

Department of Mathematics : Department of Mathematics has a Research centre approved by University of Rajasthan, Jaipur for conduction of Ph. D. program. It's research activities encompass a broad range of areas including Special Function, Operation research, Relativity, Fluid Dynamics etc. Some ongoing activities include distinguished lectures, workshops, research seminars and visitor programmes. The Department's research centre has a computer lab with latest version computers having software like 'MATLAB', 'MATHEMATICA', 'SCILAB' and many others which are very useful in the field of research.

Department of Computer Science : The Department has Computer Science and Application Research Centre approved by Rajasthan Technical University, Kota for the conduction of Ph.D. programme in the areas of Business Intelligence, Software Engineering, Big Data Analytics and Internet of Things. The Research center has state-of-the-art infrastructure, latest hardware and software, Plagiarism software for quality publication, UGC approved journals, video conferencing unit for outreach activities and high-speed internet connection are some of its assets. It is also functioning as a remote centre of NITTTR.

Dr. Manish Kaushik, Prof. R. R. Sinha, Dr. Leena Bhatia, Mr. Ashish Chandra Swami, Dr. Vikram Jain, Dr. Sonal Bordia Jain, Dr. Vaibhav Sharma, Dr. Vipin Kumar Jain and Dr. Praveen Choudhary of Department of Computer Science are recognised as research supervisors by Rajasthan Technical University, Kota.

Department of Commerce : The Department has an established Commerce Research laboratory, for the updation of theoretical and practical knowledge, creativity and efficiency of the faculty and students. It provides an opportunity to enrich knowledge and enhance research profile of the students and faculty. The lab is well equipped with computers loaded with latest software helpful for research, and various national - international research journals and books on research methodology and rich collection of latest economic reviews along with annual reports of various financial and banking institutions are available. Dr. Vikas Bairathi, Dr. Chitra Rathore and Dr. Richa Singhal are the research supervisors approved by the University of Rajasthan, Jaipur.

WI-FI ENABLED CAMPUS

With a view to keep the students updated with the current issues of local and global relevance in their field of interest, the college has a Wi-Fi enabled campus which facilitates access to the requisite information anytime, anywhere in the college. It helps in maintaining continuity in learning and digital empowerment of students. Each student in the college is provided Wi-Fi access with a unique individual login ID and space on LAN server with a separate e-mail address. It has helped all those students who can't afford internet for whole day.

IT CENTRE

IT centre in the college campus is equipped with 485 computers, in eight huge labs, all licensed software's, internet facility and high-speed networking system. The centre also provides scanner, LCDs, printers, drivers, webcams for video conferencing and internet facility that ensures smooth inter-departmental and intra / inter-institutional information exchange. The students and college staff has an easy access to the IT Centre and are provided technical help through the trained IT staff of the centre.

VIDEO CONFERENCING

To enable interactive communication between student- teacher, student- student, teacher-teacher, Subodh college has the provision of video conferencing. Video Conferencing has been integrated into the teaching practices of the college. To provide the benefits of knowledge from all over the world by interacting with researchers and other students at one click of a button. With this practice, the students have developed an inherent flair for public speaking and grown into confident individuals with better prospects of getting employed faster.

VSAT SMART CLASSROOMS

College has setup five smart classrooms with high-tech interactive boards and touch sensitive input devices including real time interaction facilities. The Smart Classroom has telecommunication facilities, with audio-video facilities to see, hear and talk to the students. The students can see, listen and participate in a lecture through a computer and an LCD projector connected to the VSAT receiver. Students interact with the faculty as spontaneously and naturally as in a regular classroom; raise queries; respond to polls and attempt multiple choice questions.

LANGUAGE LAB

Language laboratories help the students to gain more practical knowledge in comparison to traditional classroom teaching. Teachers can control, monitor, broadcast and assist students directly. A breakthrough in the traditional teaching method with the rich teaching material contents, the digital language lab strengthens student's learning attitude by providing an interactive learning environment.

This lab is also equipped with LAN as well as separate audio cabling, computers with appropriate software for conducting language exercise, headsets that block outside sounds and disturbances, a media player and recorder for listening to audio and recorded speech and a server computer or a separate storage device to store lesson materials in a digital format.

SOIL LAB

A Memorandum of Understanding has been signed between Department of Agriculture, Government of Rajasthan and the college for undertaking work on soil analysis under 'Soil Health Card Scheme'. Soil testing facilities are available and following major equipment's are present in the laboratory: Atomic Absorption Spectrophotometer, Distillation unit, Flame photometer, Colorimeter, Spectrophotometer, pH meter etc. The 'Earn While Learn' concept is a part of this soil lab and students of the college utilize their free periods to learn the various



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instrumental techniques and also get a certificate for the same.

AUDIO & VIDEO LAB

Multimedia is by definition a multi-faceted romp through the digital arts. The art of clear and meaningful visual communication is essential in every medium. Eye-catching graphics are used in print, web design, digital photography, and videography. The students will get real world knowledge in digital photography. The Department of Journalism has a provision of "Audio-Video Studio" which is equipped with online video production facilities along with professional lights and grips. The studio has Panasonic HD and Panasonic 4K cameras besides a Steadicam CURVE-BK Video Stabilizer for GoPro for film and TV production. The XIM Studio has latest still cameras like Canon 5D. It has professional LED lights with DMX controller, which could change the colors or mix colors at a given time and many more. The studio has registered Adobe Creative Cloud (academic version) for imaging and graphic design besides Final Cut Pro and Avid Media Composer for real time film and video editing.

MEDICAL HEALTH CARE

College provides health-related support services to the students, faculty and ministerial staff through its own medical room in the campus. It is well equipped with all first aid facilities for emergency cases. The college has tied up with the team of qualified doctors who provide their facility on call and one nursing staff is also employed on contract basis. Medical checkup facility for students and staff is available as and when required.

BOYS AND GIRLS HOSTEL

The college has Wi-Fi enabled separate hostel for out stationed girls located at Sanganer. Hostel has capacity of 225 girls' rooms with double and triple occupancy guarded by 24/7 security. The boy's hostel is situated at Mansarovar with the capacity of more than 75 students. Hygienic food and a homely environment are provided to the students in the hostel dining room. Visitor room is also available for the parents or guardians to meet their wards. Recreation area for yoga, table tennis, carom, chess and other indoor games are also available. LED screen, music player, DVD player, etc. have been made available in entertainment room. Newspapers and magazines have been subscribed by hostel administration for students.

PARKING

Parking spaces are very important in cities. A vast and properly guarded underground parking facility is available for both, faculty and students. More than 400 four-wheeler vehicles can be parked at the same time. For the security of the vehicles, 24-hour CCTV cameras are active. Five guards are always on duty for the security of vehicles.

OUTDOOR STADIUM

Games are an essential tool for a healthy mind and body. Understanding this importance of sports, the college has a huge



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ground for outdoor games with a seating capacity of 2500 spectators, where students can play all games like Cricket, Hockey, Football, Volleyball, Basketball etc. The courts of Badminton, Basketball, Volleyball and Lawn Tennis are designed and developed on the basis of latest technology with international standards. The college has different types of athletic equipments to be used in various athletic events. The college has appointed specific coaches for each game, with the responsibility to prepare students for the state, national and international level tournaments and championships.

INDOOR STADIUM

The college also has indoor stadium of 12500 sq. ft. which provides A-class indoor games facility for short rifle shooting range, Badminton, Table Tennis with Carom and Chess room. The stadium enables the students to play and practice whenever they get time throughout the year. Coaches are facilitated by the college so that students can learn and bring laurels to the college.

GYMNASIUM

The college has a well-maintained gymnasium equipped with Treadmill, Elliptical trainer, Recumbent Bike, Spin bike, Lat pull seated row, Leg extension leg curl, Leg press hack squat, Pec fly rear deltoid, Chest press cum shoulder press, Assisted chin dpls, Cable crossover, Smith machine, AB bench, Cross fit ring with multiple attachment, Dumbbells set, Weight set, Dumbbell rack, plate rack, rod rack, Olympic Rod set, Gym cross fit accessories set, Exercise Station (16 Station), Exercise Benches (Super Bench, Incline Bench, Flat, Preacher, Plain, Ab Bench), Dumbbells (500 Kg set), Weigh Plates, Racks, Accessories (Stepper, Gym Ball, Battle Rope, Latex Power Band Set, Gym Handle), Boxing Gloves & Bag etc. for maintaining the physical fitness. Even an exercise room is provided with trained instructor to learn more.

CAFETERIA

Cafeteria is an integral part providing comfort and conducive environment to all. It provides nutritious homely food to all students, faculty, staff members and visitors. Quality food is prepared under strict hygienic conditions. The food is served at affordable prices keeping all the sensitivities in consideration. The cafeteria remains open on all working days. There is a proper sitting arrangement too.

ELEVATOR / RAMP FACILITY

For convenient movement of physically challenged students in the college premises, the ramp facility is available at both blocks. The college also has an elevator, which is primarily available for the staff and physically challenged students for their movement to different floors in the college campus.

UNIFORM DISTRIBUTION CENTRE

The college adheres to uniform code to be worn by all the students daily, belonging to any stream of UG and PG class. The college

teaching and non-teaching staff also follows dress code which is fixed by the authorities. Since the college endorses philanthropic approach to serve the society, the college provides one set of the college uniform free of cost to the students and on subsidized price to the faculty. The college has a Uniform Distribution Centre from where a student can collect uniform of their respective sizes.

COMMON ROOM

Institution also provides the facility of common room for boys and girls. The common rooms serve as a centre of recreational activities for the students as they indulge in discussions on various topics related to their interest area and also play

various games like carom, table tennis, chess etc. to de-stress themselves.

REST ROOM

The college is spread over five floors and each floor has clean and hygienic rest rooms. Every rest room is equipped with all basic amenities.

FIRE ALARMS AND SECURITY SYSTEM

The college building comprises of class rooms, lecture theatres, laboratories, seminar halls and sports facilities. Each area poses a different type of fire and security risk, especially science labs that contain flammable chemicals. College has effective and well-maintained fire alarms and security systems and fully trained users to ensure protection of students, buildings, equipment's and infrastructure as a whole.

SOLAR PLANT

Energy is one of the most fundamental needs of our universe. Solar energy is the core source of all energies on earth. It is the most readily, freely available, non-polluting and the most abundant renewable energy source. The college has solar plant of 40 KW, thus contributing in its own way towards the sustainable environment.

CENTRAL INSTRUMENTATION LABORATORY

The college has created the Central Instrumentation Laboratory with an object of providing a central facility of latest and advanced analytical instruments for research. It has been playing a pivotal role in supporting the research activities of the different departments of Science, Commerce and Humanities. Central Instrumentation Laboratory of the college caters to the needs of the students, research scholars and teachers of the college in order to promote research activities. It is presently having instruments like X-ray diffractometer, FT-IR spectrophotometer, Fluorescence microscope, PCR machine, cooling centrifuge, centrifuge with rotator, Plant growth chamber, ultracentrifuge, optical microscope with camera, Turnitin software, MATLAB software, UV transilluminator, Digital microscope with LCD screen, Hematology analyser, RTPCR, UV-VIS Spectrophotometer, Incubator shaker, Plant Growth Chamber, Centrifuge, Thermocycler, BOD incubator, LAF, Electrophoresis, etc

INNOVATION HUB

The college developed Innovation Hub under DBT Star Scheme. The college hosts the Innovation Hub to conduct innovative product, process and service testing that enhances industry competitiveness. It boosts regional economic development while serving as an experiential learning and resource hub for our students and the broader community. Some of the equipment's through which we are trying to do our best efforts to develop scientific and innovation skills among students are: Anharmonic Oscillator, Zeeman Effect, Newton Cradle, Air Canon, Kepler Law, Inclined motion, Manual Lift, Diffraction through water waves, Joe Cell etc.

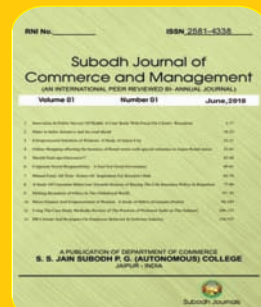

Moreover, the college has its in-house publications, the college newsletter 'Subodh Newsletter' featuring news in and around the campus along with creative writings by the students as well as the faculty members that connect the college with an external community. Library develops a sense of responsibility in the pursuit of knowledge in each student.

Library Rules and Regulations

- Entry in the library is strictly through Identity cum Library card.
- Two books to UG level students and three books to PG level students can be issued at a time for 14 days and if the book is not in demand the same can be reissued for further 14 days.
- If the book is not deposited in scheduled time, a fine of Rs. 10/- per day per book will be charged.
- If the issued book is lost, the responsibility has to be borne by the borrower and he/she has to deposit another copy of the book of the same or the latest edition. If the book is not replaced, one has to deposit double cost of the book as a fine.
- Any damage caused to the library property and books of the library, in terms of writing, underlining or tearing the pages, is subjected to the disciplinary action as per the college rules.
- As the library is automated /computerized hence, any damage caused to the barcode of the book is subjected to a fine of Rs. 100/- for each book.
- Students have to pay Rs. 100/- for the loss of Identity cum Library card.
- Apart from the above rules, the library has a booklet of rules and regulations which is available at the counter.
- As per the Government directives from time to time, wearing masks and maintaining social distance will be compulsory in the library and college premises
